

## Young Adult Cambridge Exam Preparation

**Course Aim:** The CEC Young Adult Programme is designed for international students aged between 16 -19 who wish to prepare for Cambridge Exams with other learners of a similar age.

**Course Description:** The programme includes 4 hours of English language tuition and exam preparation per day during the morning, with an additional two afternoons of exam practice. Activities and excursions are scheduled on other days. This course is ideal for students who wish to bring their language and exam knowledge up to the level required for the exam. Students can sit the exam at CEC at the end of their course as CEC is an official Cambridge testing centre.
