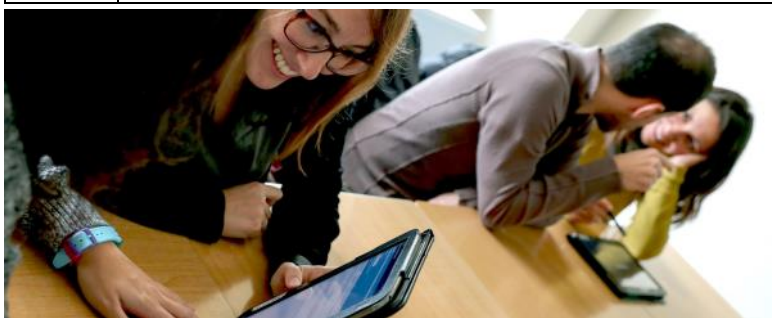
General English - AE107
